Accommodation

Your Malvern experience is also about where you live: the people you meet, the relationships you build and the neighbourhoods you explore.

We offer two types of accommodation, staying in somebody's house (homestay) or living in university accommodation (residence).

Homestay

Homestay is a chance to experience local life and practise your English, to learn things from your host that you would probably never learn in the classroom. Our hosts reflect the diversity of their cities, including where and how they live, their occupations, and their lifestyles. But all of them are curious about international students and other cultures, and enthusiastic about sharing their lives and interests with others. All hosts are inspected in line with British Council accreditation criteria and hosts for under-18s are police (DBS) checked.

Homestay features included as standard:

- Single room
- Shared bathroom
- Bed linen, towels
- Wifi
- Access to a washing machine

Options:

- Meal plan: self catering, breakfast (B&B), breakfast and dinner (half board)
- Private bathroom
- Twin (shared) room
- Special diets

Homestay hosts are 25-60 minutes travel from the school.
Minimum stay: one week, all stays start and end on a Sunday

Residence

Residence accommodation is recommended for students who appreciate being independent, prefer to cook for themselves, and live in a social setting with fellow international students. All accommodation has been inspected for comfort, suitability and location.

We have year-round adult residence options and also U-18 residence options for the summer.

Main Manchester Residence

Lambert and Fairfield residence is next to Manchester Piccadilly Train Station. the building offers high quality ensuite rooms with a double bed, shower, desk, and wardrobe. The shared kitchen includes an oven with electric hob, a fridge freezer, kettle, and microwave.

There is plenty of great entertainment nearby: Canal Street, the Northern Quarter and the main shopping areas are within easy walking distance. Inside the residence there are also outstanding amenities including: use of a private bowling alley, study area, cinema room, gym and games room, including pool table and table tennis.

The residence is less than a 10-minute walk to the school and the local shops.



Main London Residence

Will Wyatt Court is located in Zone 1, near London's vibrant Hoxton and Shoreditch districts, the building offers an excellent range of ensuite rooms with modern decor, a small double bed with underbed storage, as well as a study area with USB charging ports. The residence also has a well-equipped shared kitchen area and living area.

You'll have plenty of entertainment on your doorstep, with East London icons like Boxpark and Brick Lane waiting to be discovered, and pretty Shoreditch Park just down the road.

Bus and train links are within a few minutes' walk, and the school is 20 minutes away by public transport (two underground stops).
